RE: Addendum No. 1
2026-003 Flint Hill Road Water Line Extension

The following items are changes and/or clarifications of the plans and specifications and shall be included in the Bid. This Addendum shall supersede in the event of any conflicts. The Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of all Addenda in the appropriate space on the Bid Form. Failure to do so may result in disqualification of the Bid.

1. Are work time constraints included in the project?

Response: Contractors will not be limited to specific working hours. However, if work is performed outside of the District's daily 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. work schedule or on weekends, the contractor must photograph installed pipe, fittings, valves, etc., before backfilling.

2. Are steel tracks allowed on County roadways?

Response: Steel tracks are not permissible on Country or State roadways.

3. Was the tie-in made at the Hwy 720 bore near Copelin Rd?

Response: Yes. The tie-in at the north side of Hwy 720 was installed on the existing 6", the encasement pipe was loaded with 6" PVC carrier pipe, and the 6" tee configuration was installed on the south side of Hwy 720.

4. Will the District GPS the new waterline for as-built plans?

Response: Yes. The District will collect GPS data points for newly installed pipe, fittings, valves, etc., to prepare as-built record drawings. The Contractor will need to notate any deviations on their construction plans.

5. Changes to Waterline Plans:

- a. Easement notes have been added to the waterline plans for each property. Easements start from the edge of road right-of-way or property line and across the road frontage of the property, unless otherwise noted.
 - b. Plan Sheet 9 has been updated to show the proposed Fire Hydrant Setting installation near Sta 50+60.
 - c. Plan Sheets 13 and 14 have been updated to show the proposed waterline alignment through the Nolin RECC Electric easement (30' width, 15' from center) at Sta 177+75 to Sta 191+75. The waterline must be installed at minimum 10' offset from electric poles.
6. **Section C-410, Bid Form** – the Bid Form has been updated with corrected quantities. Item No. 2, 4" PVC, C900 DR 18 Pipe increased by 125 LF for a total of 19,990 LF. Item No. 4, Fire Hydrant Setting decreased by 1 EA for a total of 1 EA.
7. **Section C-510, Notice of Award** – the Notice of Award form has been updated to reflect the correct quantities for 4" C900 DR 18 PVC pipe.
8. **Section C-520, Agreement** – the Agreement has been updated to reflect the correct quantities for 4" C900 DR 18 PVC pipe.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN OWNER AND CONTRACTOR FOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT (STIPULATED PRICE)

This Agreement is by and between **Hardin County Water District No. 2** (“Owner”) and
_____ (“Contractor”).

Terms used in this Agreement have the meanings stated in the General Conditions and the Supplementary Conditions.

Owner and Contractor hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1—WORK

1.01 Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract Documents. The Work is generally described as follows:

Installation of Owner provided water line and encasement materials, including approximately 11,035 L.F. of 6” C900 DR 18 PVC pipe, 19,990 L.F. of 4” C900 DR 18 PVC pipe, 60 L.F. of bored encasement for 4” PVC carrier pipe in 12” steel casing, and all necessary appurtenances.

ARTICLE 2—THE PROJECT

2.01 The Project, of which the Work under the Contract Documents is a part, is generally described as follows: **Construction of the Flint Hill Road Water Line Extension.**

ARTICLE 3—ENGINEER

3.01 The Owner has retained **Kenvirons, LLC** (“Engineer”) to provide design services for the Project. The Owner will administer bidding and related preconstruction activities. Following bid opening and award of the Contract, the Owner will administer the Contract and the Project. Engineer may provide limited assistance to Owner if requested, but Engineer shall not be deemed to assume the duties, responsibilities, rights, or authority assigned to Engineer during construction except as specifically authorized by Owner.

3.02 The part of the Project that pertains to the Work has been designed by the Engineer.

ARTICLE 4—CONTRACT TIMES

4.01 *Time is of the Essence*

A. All time limits for Milestones, if any, Substantial Completion, and completion and readiness for final payment as stated in the Contract Documents are of the essence of the Contract.

4.02 *Contract Times: Days*

A. No separate time is established for Substantial Completion. The Work shall be fully completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions by **October 25, 2026.**
